Approve February 14<sup>th</sup> Minutes

Announcement: Rosa Hallowell, former member of the CWMTF and descendent of two officers in the 54<sup>th</sup>, advised the Task Force that on June 1st, a National Rededication Ceremony of the Shaw 54<sup>th</sup> Memorial on Boston Common, will be held in front of the State House on Beacon Street. This ceremony will take place the day after the 125<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Shaw Memorial [May 31<sup>st</sup>, 1897].

The Augustus Saint-Gauden's sculpture of Shaw and his regiment was called the *first soldier's monument to be raised to a particular set of comparatively undistinguished men*.

Beth van Duzer will summarize her conversation with Jon Harris, Concord's Budgeting and Purchasing Director, regarding requirements for RFQ's and RFP's for monument/tablet work, as well as potential gifts to the Town for the project.

Ongoing discussion: Vendors proposals to remove the existing 48"x66"x1 1/2" tablet, clean and preserve the monument and design/install the new tablet, same dimensions. [David Wood and Tish Hopkins].
