(Bad weather date: Saturday, Feb. 5, at noon. Same location.)**

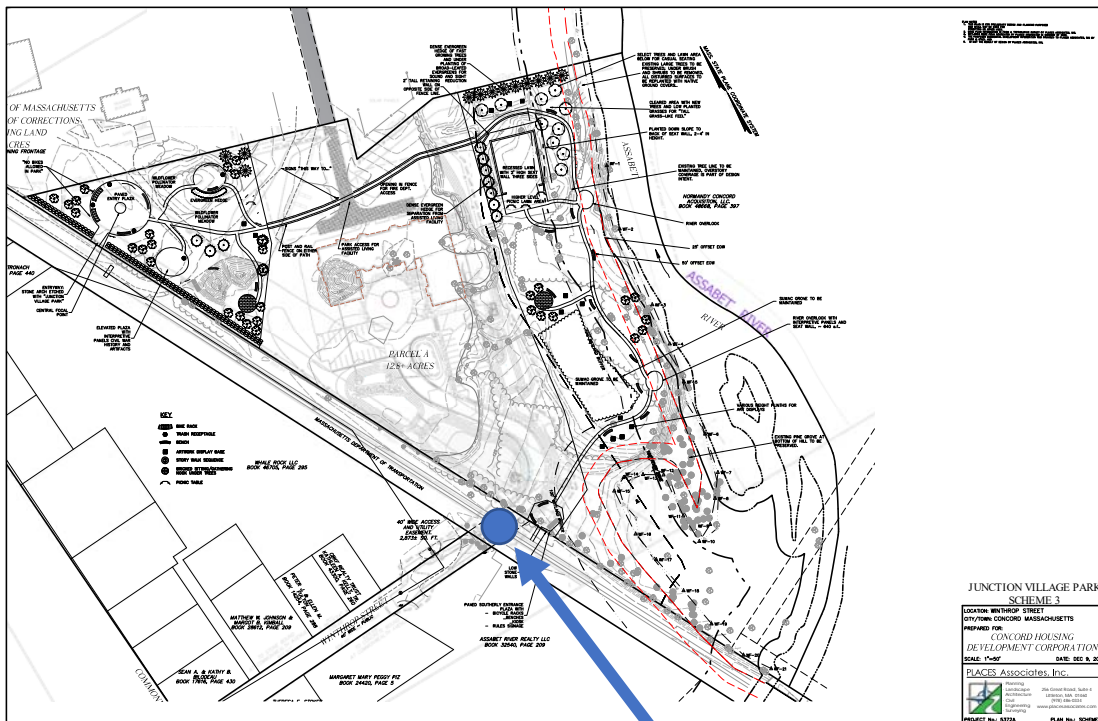
Administrative business:

Members of the Junction Village Open Space Task Force will lead a walk at the site of proposed accessible conservation land along the Assabet River where it stretches behind the MCI property and perpendicular to the Bruce Freeman Rail Trail. Two areas will be included on the walk:

- A 1.43-acre, flat, triangle or wedge of land to the northwest of what will be Christopher Heights at Junction Village, an 83-unit assisted living facility set to be built on 4+ acres as early as next spring.
- A 6.68-acre, largely wooded parcel that stretches from the rail trail and along the river toward the back of the MCI property.

Please note: The site consists of uneven ground and could have snowy or icy areas. Shoe spikes and walking sticks are recommended.
