

Concord Cultural Council

Meeting minutes

Oct. 23, 2019

Present: Tom Martin, chairman, Alicia Cleary, Terry Yulanovich, Betsy Levinson, Tracy Winn, selectman's observer Terri Ackerman and Beth Williams, tourism manager for the Town of Concord.

The meeting was called to order at 6:04 p.m. by Chairman Tom Martin.

Minutes from the September 4 and October 2 meetings were accepted and Betsy will send on to Jeremy Romanule at the Town House.

Applications are in for the 2019-2020 grant year. We got 32 applications.

In cases where the application was incomplete or didn't comply with application regulations, Terry will send a notification by email on how to rectify it within the three-week window.

The CCC has \$6,859 to allocate this year. The applications total \$20,430.

Tom was thanked for his superior skill at organizing, numbering and printing out the applications that were distributed.

With 5 council members and 32 apps, it was determined that each member would review 6, with two of us taking on 7.

The Concord council will continue, at least this year, to reimburse applicants rather than provide grant money outright, the way some 50 other towns in the state do now.

The next meeting is Nov. 20 at 6 p.m. with another on Dec. 4 and Jan. 8.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:29 p.m.
