Holly called the meeting to order at 2:00 PM.

Minutes from the September 21, 2022, meeting were accepted.

The meeting of the Concord 2025 Executive and Subcommittees on October 16<sup>th</sup> at the Museum was reviewed and emerging themes for the celebration were noted.

Holly reported she has met with local representatives of the DAR and the Sons of the Revolution.

Carol reported she had met with the local Girl Scouts to discuss nature of their participation.
