Rideout Park Dedication

CONCORD, MA— The Rideout Park Dedication is scheduled for October 26th at 5:00pm at Rideout Park, 61 Laws Brook Road. The dedication is open to the public to celebrate the improvements made to the park.

A land purchase from the Anderson Family of Concord made the park expansion and improvements possible. Among the notable improvements made were an increased number of parking spots from 26 and 1 ADA accessible spot to 48 and 2 ADA accessible spots. A community park feel was created by moving the parking area to a less prominent area while also making the parking area safer for pedestrians with turning areas. Restrooms were renovated to become ADA accessible.

The hardscapes were hidden using native deciduous trees and flowering vegetation creating natural barriers. Sidewalks have been extended around the property borders, creating an easy walking path and more enjoyable park experience. A bioretention pond and rain gardens were added to create an aesthetically pleasing area that also assists in sustainable storm water management. Other improvements include environmentally friendly Playground Safety Fibar, a biodegradable mulch under the play structure and a more traditional outfield fence.
