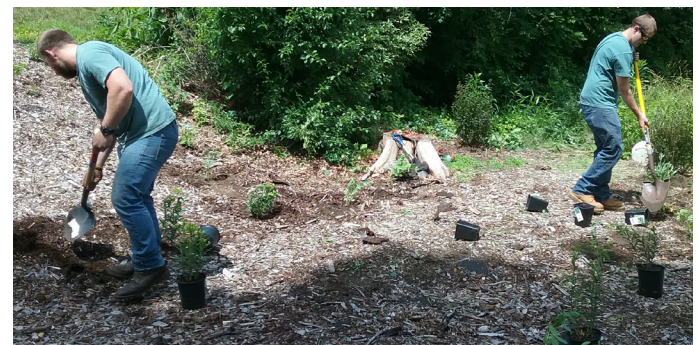
### Beede and Books

## Invasive Species Pull

The Invasive Species Pull originally to be on June 28th was postponed until June 29th due to strong thunderstorms moving through the area on Thursday. Despite the delay, the community project went very well with 11 community volunteers working alongside DNR staff, community groups including OARS, and Liz Trabucco, Grants and Programs Coordinator for the National Park Foundation, who flew up from Washington D.C. to join us for this event.

Great progress was made, removing seven dump truck loads of invasives from the site. Additional work to be accomplished through the summer and fall include additional invasives removal, chipping up trees that were removed to use for the trail surface and picnic area, removal of metal debris, and installation of picnic tables, signs and a parking area.
