



## **OUTDOOR RECREATIONAL FACILITIES – EMERSON TRACK**

**ARTICLE 21.** To determine whether the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, or transfer from available funds in the Treasury, or authorize the Town Treasurer with the approval of the Select Board, to borrow by the issuance of bonds or notes under the provisions of Chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, the sum of \$100,000, or any other sum, for resurfacing of the Emerson Field Track and related work, said funds to be expended under the direction of the Town Manager, or take any other action relative thereto.

**The Emerson Track originally built in 1925 as a cinder was Fully Re-Constructed in 1999 at a cost of \$225,000, half raised through donations.**

**Track is actively used for CCHS Boys and Girls Teams**

**Track also very heavily used by residents of all ages for running and walking**





**Track should be re-striped and painted with non-skid surface every five years.**

**Last Repainted in 2011 – 3 coats of urethane paint and white striping**

**Offer received last week from Middlesex School to paint the track with two donations: \$50,000 immediately and \$50,000 after July 1**
