- There are 3 State-owned properties within the Town of Concord that will require a permanent easement to allow construction of the Rail Trail.
- The two state agencies affected are the Department of Corrections and the Executive Office of Transportation.



Article 13 - Bruce Freeman Rail Trail Right of Way – Grant of Easement


Easements are needed over these properties for:
