## Article 10 PEG Access Fund

2015 Annual Town Meeting voted under Article 37 to accept MGL c.53F- 3/4 thereby creating PEG Access and Cable-Related Fund

Payments formerly made by Comcast to CCTV are now made directly to Town of Concord

Anticipated Payments in FY2017: \$468,000

Prior Balance: \$ 92,000

Three-year contract signed with CCTV in January

Law Requires Town Meeting to Appropriate Funds

Annually. Funds may only be used for PEG services
