Dear Interested Citizens,

After recently updating its Master Plan, paying particular attention to the supply of gravesites, the Concord Cemetery Committee, in conjunction with Cemetery Superintendent Dan Rowley and Cemetery Supervisor Tish Hopkins, is holding a public information meeting to inform Concord residents about proposals being considered for the cemetery on the subject of gravesite supply. We wanted to notify you of this upcoming meeting in hope that you will attend.

The meeting will be held at 7:00 pm on Wednesday, November 7 in the Hearing Room on the second floor of the Concord Town House, 22 Monument Square, Concord, MA 01742.

The Cemetery Committee wants to utilize available space in the cemetery to meet Concord's needs in ways that honor the cemetery's importance to the town. We are welcoming public commentary concerning a number of alternative burial categories, including proposals for the addition of a columbarium and mausoleums. We wish to encourage any citizen of Concord interested in our historic cemetery and its place in the community to attend.
