Early Voting was held October 29th through November 2nd at the Town House, 3,087 people came to vote early.



HDC Public Neighborhood Meeting

Main Street Historic District: The Concord Historic Districts Commission (HDC) will host a public neighborhood meeting on Wednesday, November 14, 2018 at 7:00pm in the Town House Hearing Room, 22 Monument Square.

This is an opportunity for residents within the proposed expansion area and other interested parties to learn more about the reasons for considering expansion of the Main Street Historic District and the HDC's application and review process. 
