2019 DOG LICENSING BEGINS ON TUESDAY, DECEMBER 11 at 8:30 AM

CONCORD, MA—All dogs ages 6 months and older are required to be vaccinated against rabies and must be licensed where the dog resides.

Dog licenses are issued on a first come, first served basis, so if you want a low tag number, don't delay! You may license your dog(s) in person, online, or by mail **beginning Tuesday, December 11th at 8:30 am.**

In person: 22 Monument Square, Mon – Fri: 8:30 am – 4:30 pm

By mail: 22 Monument Square, Concord, MA 01742

What you need

- Rabies vaccination certificate – must be current (may be on file at Town Clerk's Office, if renewing or using a local veterinarian; email us if you are unsure)
- Owner information
- Dog name, breed, and age
- Payment: \$15 (\$20 if not spayed / neutered) cash or check (payable to "Town of Concord"). Online payments require credit or debit card payments.
- Kennel licensing fees vary if you have more than 3 dogs
- Self-addressed, stamped envelope (1 dog = 71¢; 2 dogs = 92¢)

Important deadlines

March 31, 2019: Grace period for dog licensing ends

April 1, 2019: \$25 late fee applies along with possible fines
