

Article 9 Concord Public Schools Renovations

Ms. Snook moves that the Town vote to raise and appropriate, or transfer from available funds in the treasury, or authorize the Town Treasurer with the approval of the Board of Selectmen to borrow money by the issuance of bonds or notes under the provisions of Chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws the sum of \$450,000, or any other sum, to be expended under the direction of the Town Manager for remodeling, reconstructing or making extraordinary repairs, including original equipment and related work at various Concord Public School facilities, or take any other action relative thereto.

Note to Moderator: 2/3 vote required.

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- The FY2015 Town Manager's Capital Plan allows funding \$800,000 for CPS projects
- Our request is reduced by \$350,000 to fund the School portion of the Knox Trail Land acquisition approved at the 2013 Special Town Meeting allowing for \$450,000 of improvements with FY2015 funding
