### Natural Resources

As a first step to establishing a few pollinator meadows in Town, a local arborist removed the trees at Barretts Mill Farm in front of the red barn as part of a chainsaw safety training exercise. The understory, consisting mainly of invasive shrubs, will be removed next, with care taken not to damage the old farm-stand foundation. Following removal of all vegetation, the Barretts Mill farmers will cover the site with a greenhouse grade plastic and the site will be "solarized" for several weeks to kill off weed seeds in the soil.

## **CONCORD CLEANUP**

**Saturday, March 30<sup>th</sup> – Sunday, April 7<sup>th</sup>**

The annual cleanup of our community from roadside litter and trash on public lands begins on Saturday, March 30<sup>th</sup> and continues through Sunday, April 7<sup>th</sup>, with the major emphasis on Saturday, April 6<sup>th</sup>.

The Division of Natural Resources will supply yellow bags for miscellaneous litter and clear bags for recyclables (bottles and cans only – no paper), and CPW crews will pick up the bags along the roadside and at intersections beginning Monday, April 8th.
