

Article 32 – Purchase of Ambulance Equipment

To determine whether the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, or transfer from available funds in the Treasury, or authorize the Town Treasurer with the approval of the Board of Selectmen, to borrow by the issuance of bonds or notes under the provisions of Chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, the sum of \$75,000, or any other sum, for the purposes of financing the cost of purchasing equipment for a new ambulance that was donated to the Town and which will be placed into service on or about July 1, 2014, said funds to be expended under the direction of the Town Manager, or take any other action relative thereto.


Current Service Level
