

ARTICLE 19. Mr. Whelan moves: that the Town take affirmative action on Article 19 as printed in the Warrant.



ARTICLE 19. To determine whether the Town will vote to amend the Town Meeting Notice Bylaw by deleting the phrase "in at least one public location in each precinct in Concord" and inserting in place thereof the phrase: "and electronically on the town's website" in the first sentence of that Bylaw…



...so that the Bylaw reads as follows (changes are shown in bold and strikeout for emphasis only):

"Notice of Town Meeting shall be given by posting an attested copy of the Warrant calling the same at the Concord Town House in at least one public location in each precinct in Concord and electronically on the town's website, at least seven days before the day appointed for an annual Town Meeting, and at least fourteen days before the day appointed for any special Town Meeting. A copy of the Warrant of any Town Meeting shall also be sent by mail or otherwise to every household in Concord..."



"...at least seven days before the day appointed for an annual Town Meeting, and at least fourteen days before the day appointed for any special Town Meeting. A copy of the Warrant of any Town Meeting shall also be sent by mail or otherwise to every household in Concord, and upon request, to places of religious assembly in Concord, at least seven days before an annual Town Meeting, and at least fourteen days before a special Town Meeting, and the return of the officer that he or she has complied by this bylaw shall be conclusive that he has done so."

Massachusetts Legislature An Act validating certain proceedings of the town of Concord

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 10 of chapter 39 of the General Laws or any other general or special law or town by-law or charter provision to the contrary, all acts, proceedings and votes taken by the town of Concord at its special town meeting on October 1, 2018 and all actions taken pursuant thereto are hereby ratified, validated and confirmed to the same extent as if notice of the meeting had been published as required by law.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
