SPECIAL TOWN MEETING DECEMBER 4, 2013

LAND ACQUISITION – 55 AND 55R KNOX TRAIL (Acton)

ARTICLE 1. Upon a **MOTION** made by Christopher Whelan and duly seconded, and further amended by William Plummer and duly seconded, the following was **VOTED BY TWO-THIRDS MAJORITY**, and so declared by the Moderator:

That the Town authorize the Board of Selectmen to acquire by purchase on such terms as the Selectmen may determine, for municipal purposes including vehicle storage, repair, fueling, and other uses, the fee, easement and/or other property interests in, on, over, across, under and along all or any portion of the property located at 55 and 55R Knox Trail in Acton, Massachusetts, shown on the Acton Assessors map 14 as parcels 9-3 and 9-6, together with any structures, improvements and trees thereon, and authorize the Board of Selectmen to grant rights in a portion of the property to the Concord School Committee, on terms mutually satisfactory to the Selectmen and the School Committee, to be used for parking, maintenance and fueling of school buses and other educational purposes, but not to be used by a contractor in support of outsourced transportation, and further that the Town appropriate the sum of \$700,000 to be expended by the Board of Selectmen for such acquisition and authorize the Town Treasurer with the approval of the Board of Selectmen, to borrow said amount under the provisions of Chapter 44, §7(3) of the Massachusetts General Laws.
