

Article 8 Concord Public Schools Renovations

Motion: To determine whether the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, or transfer from available funds in the treasury, or authorize the Town Treasurer with the approval of the Board of Selectmen to borrow money by the issuance of bonds or notes under the provisions of Chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws the sum of \$795,000, or any other sum, to be expended under the direction of the Town Manager for remodeling, reconstructing or making extraordinary repairs, including original equipment and related work at various Concord Public School facilities, or take any other action relative thereto.

Note to Moderator: 2/3 vote required.

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■ FY2014 Option A

- In conjunction with Article 13, \$475,000 of this article's \$795,000 would be used to develop transportation infrastructure needed to retain in-house student transportation and reduce operating costs.

■ FY2014 Option B

- If Article 13 fails deferred projects would resume as depicted in the upcoming Option B slide.

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■ FY2014 Option A

- Alcott – Heating System & Paving Repairs \$70K
- Thoreau – Field Irrigation & ERU Replacement \$50K
- Peabody – Electrical Improvements \$100K
- Sanborn – Heating Univents Replacement \$100K
- Transportation Infrastructure at Landfill \$475K

Total \$795K

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■ FY2014 Option B

- Alcott – Heating System & Paving Repairs \$70K
- Thoreau – Field Irrigation & Paving Repairs \$70K
- Peabody & Sanborn
 - Electrical Improvements \$250K
 - Roofing \$240K
 - HVAC Control System \$165K
