

## CPW Storm Response

High-wind and heavy rain events on October 16th - 17th and October 31st - November 1st resulted in over 60 responses by the Highway & Grounds Division team members throughout the Town of Concord.

Emergency response included removing tree debris from roadways, sidewalks and both private & public proprieties. Division staff worked overnight during the storm and for multiple days following each storm cutting, chipping and hauling tree debris

## Community Preservation Update

A public informational hearing will be held by the Town of Concord's Community Preservation Committee on Tuesday, November 19, 2019 at 7:00PM in the First Floor Meeting Room, 141 Keyes Road, Concord, Massachusetts for review and public comment on the proposed applications for 2020 Community Preservation Act funding.

At the October 23rd meeting, the Committee heard presentations about four applications – the Regional Housing Services Program; the Assabet River Pedestrian Bridge Construction Drawings and Permitting; the Warner's Pond Dredging Project and Restoration, Repainting and Gilding the Belfry at First Parish Church of Concord.

At the October 29th meeting, the Committee heard presentations regarding Gerow Park Improvements Phase I; White Pond Beach Improvements; Buttrick House Gardens Hardscape Rehabilitation; and 58 Monument Square Roof Replacement.
