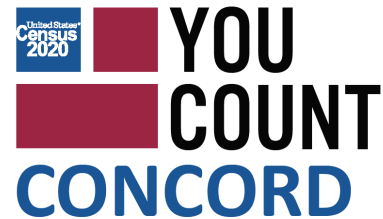
2020 Town Meeting Warrant

The 2020 Town Meeting Warrant closed on January 10th. This year's warrant includes 52 total articles with 9 citizen petitions. Town meeting is scheduled to begin on April 27th, 2020.

Grant Funding from Mass. Cultural Council

Massachusetts Cultural Council grants awarded to Concord Center and West Concord Junction: Letters from the MCC were received over the holidays awarding grant funding to Concord's Cultural Districts – Concord Center (\$5,000) and West Concord Junction (\$6,000). Concord Center Cultural District Committee plans to use its grant funding for promotion of a film festival in late spring/early summer and the West Concord Junction Cultural District Committee will use its funding to convert last year's ArtWeek mural into a weather-proof outdoor mural to be installed on the 'Reasons to be Cheerful' building at 110-112 Commonwealth Ave.
