Members of the Board,

On behalf of our client, Concord Country Club, we have revised the attached Irrigation Pond Plan, dated February 14, 2020. Changes have been made in response to comments received via a letter from Elizabeth Hughes to Greg Cincotta, dated February 7, 2020:

1. Our office has performed additional survey work so that a 100' wide strip surrounding the earth removal area is now shown. The nearest lot line and all manmade features are now also shown.
2. Notes have been added to the plan specifying that all disturbed earthen surfaces will be loamed and seeded with the exception of the interior of the irrigation pond, which will be plastic lined.


Additionally, Onyx Corporation has provided specifications regarding proposed trucking methods for the earth removal; materials outlining the proposed trucking methods are attached hereto.

Dear Mr. Rappoccio,

Onyx will control the dust with a water truck as needed. We have placed crushed stone along the whole road out of the golf course as well as a construction entrance containing 2-4" crushed stone to prevent mud from leaving the site. We will also have a drivable sweeper for the road on site if needed. The types of vehicles hauling material will consist primarily of 6 wheelers, tri axles and dump trailers.

Hours of operation are Monday- Friday 7:00am to 4:00pm. Saturday 7:00am – 1:00pm.

No pickups on Sundays or major holidays.

No vehicles will be able to park on the street and all pickups will be made on the jobsite.

All vehicles removing material from the site will use the most direct routes to Rt. 2 and Rt. 62 doing our best to avoid backroads as much as possible.
