## CONCORD-CARLISLE SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The Concord Carlisle Scholarship Fund is a tax-exempt charitable trust affiliated with New England Dollars for Scholars, a program of Scholarship America. Established in 1966, the Fund provides need-based grants to assist deserving young women and men obtain, to the fullest extent possible, the benefit of additional educational opportunities that may be open to them after completion of their secondary school studies. The Fund is administered by a 19-member, all-volunteer board of trustees. Scholarships are financed by an annual appeal, by a student-staffed phonathon, and by income generated from memorial gifts, bequests, and named funds. Grant recipients must either reside, or have attended school, in Concord or Carlisle. Since its inception, the Fund has assisted over 900 students. 
