

**Climate Action Advisory Board
Director's Update
July 15, 2020**



CSEC Sustainable Home Outreach Project – The Comprehensive Sustainability and Energy Committee (CSEC), in collaboration with CMLP and Water/Sewer Division, have completed a pamphlet that highlights actions residents can take to improve the sustainability of their home. The pamphlet is available on the web at concordma.gov/yoursustainablehome. The committee had planned to launch a number of outreach activities this year to promote the resource but they are now discussing how to adapt for virtual engagement.

UNH Summer Sustainability Fellow – Abigail Ahern, a summer sustainability fellow through the UNH Sustainability Institute, is working with the town this summer on a project to develop sustainability guidelines for historic and older homes.

MVP Action Grant – The town submitted an application in June for an MVP Action Grant to fund an integrated water management plan, one of the priority actions in the climate action and resilience plan. Award notification is expected late summer or early fall.

Climate Action and Resilience Plan – The plan's landing page concordma.gov/climateplan has been updated with the completed plan documents as well as background and planning materials. In conjunction with the plan development, we have also established an online dashboard which will be launched later this month.
