Monday, October 5	Ballots are delivered to the Town Clerk's Office from the printer
Tuesday, October 6	Ballots mailing begins to more than 7,000 voters
Saturday, October 17	Early voting in person begins at the Town House: 12pm - 4pm
Sunday, October 18	Early voting at the Town House: 12pm - 4pm
Saturday, October 24	Early Voting at the Town House: 12pm - 4pm Voter reg. deadline: 2pm - 4pm / 6pm - 8pm <a href="https://www.sec.state.ma.us/ovr/">https://www.sec.state.ma.us/ovr/</a>
Sunday, October 25	Early voting at the Town House: 12pm - 4pm
Monday, October 26	Early voting at the Town House: 8:30am - 4:30pm

Friday, October 30	<b>Last Day of early voting</b> at the Town House: 8:30am - 4:30pm
Monday, November 2	12:00pm deadline to apply for an absentee ballot in person
Tuesday, November 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Presidential Election: vote at regular polling places; polls are open from 7:00am until 8:00pm</b></li><li>• Central Tabulation Facility in the Town House Hearing Room opens at 6:00am</li><li>• Hand delivered ballots are due by 8:00pm. All mail in ballots must be postmarked by November 3<sup>rd</sup> and be received by November 6<sup>th</sup>.</li><li>• Overseas mailed ballots must be postmarked by November 3<sup>rd</sup> and be received by November 13<sup>th</sup> at 5:00pm.</li></ul>

- ✓ Apply for a vote by mail ballot
- ✓ **Return your ballot to the Town Clerk's Office** by 8:00pm on November 3<sup>rd</sup>. Ballots will not be accepted at the polls on Election Day. They must be returned to the Town Clerk's Office.
- ✓ Mailed ballots must be postmarked by November 3<sup>rd</sup> and received by 5:00pm on November 6<sup>th</sup>.
