


Representatives from Lincoln, Concord and Acton created Route 2 Corridor Advisory Committee (CAC)




From 1994 – 2010 the CAC met every 3 months in an open public forum to discuss the project

CONTRACTOR WORK SCHEDULE & RESTRICTIONS:

Typical Operations:

- Daily: Monday thru Friday 7am – 3:30pm
- Nights & Weekends: Allowed with MassDOT approval

Restricted Work Days:

- The day before or the day after a long weekend which involves a Holiday without prior MassDOT approval




CONTRACTOR WORK SCHEDULE & RESTRICTIONS:

Route 2 Traffic Restrictions:

- 2-Lanes in each direction to remain open: 6am – 10am, 2:30pm – 7pm
- Optional 1-Lane in each direction may remain open: 10am – 2:30pm, nights 8pm – 6am


