The Concord Town House was built in 1851 and has served as the home for Town Offices and related operations, public assembly, and historic record storage. The Town has monitored the condition of the brownstone trim since 2005 and determined that much of the original brownstone had become severely compromised, creating a safety hazard.

In 2013, complete exterior renovations were undertaken to repoint the bricks, replace deteriorated brownstone, cast some replica brownstone, remove fire escapes, reset the front steps, repaint trim in historic colors, and bring interior aspects up to code while providing energy efficiency to the building envelope.
