S.2995 NextGen Climate Bill – The Select Board submitted a letter of support (attached) for S.2995, the NextGen Climate Bill, to the Governor's Office on January 4th. The [Governor vetoed the bill](#) on January 14th.

Electric Home Case Study Project – CSEC is taking on a project to collect and produce case studies about Concord residents who have electric homes, using heat pumps and other climate-friendly home improvements. Summer fellow – Concord has been approved to participate in the UNH Sustainability Fellowship program again this summer, bringing on another intern to work with Kate. This year's project is scoped around researching and recommending financing mechanisms for energy efficiency and electrification.
