ANNUAL TOWN ELECTION

Voter Registration Deadline is Friday, March 5, 2021

The last day for residents to register to vote at the March 25, 2021 Annual Town Election is Friday, March 5, 2021.

Do I need to reregister for every election?

No need to reregister if you're already a voter at your current address.

In person (by appointment: 978-318-3080): We are open until 8:00pm on March 5th for voter registration.

By mail. Must be postmarked by March 5th

Turning 18 after the deadline but before or on March 25th?

Pre-register now, but no later than the March 5th deadline.

Wednesday, March 24	12:00pm deadline to apply for an absentee ballot in person <u>by appointment</u>
