Dear Concord Planning & Land Management:

The Landscape Slope Area Plan for the Center & Main development indicates proposed plantings along the rear of lots 1-5 to assist with slope mitigation. These are groundcover type plantings with fibrous root systems that will bind soil and prevent erosion once established. They are a variety of deciduous shrubs, including Lowbush Blueberry, Grow-Low Sumac, and Stephanandra, with the addition of an evergreen spreading juniper variety for consistent color and winter foliage. These plants can be expected to spread and cover the slope area while binding the soil with their fibrous root systems which will prevent future erosion in this area.
