

Dear Community Preservation Committee:

White Pond is an incredible jewel in Concord. This was a pond that Thoreau also walked, formed from glaciers thousands of years ago. It is a place that families have been bringing their children for decades to swim, paddle, and as they get older, to become lifeguards or move back and bring their own kids. Yet, the pond has had cyanobacteria blooms that are unhealthy and dangerous for people and animals, last year keeping the pond closed the entire summer.

We greatly support the Community Preservation Committee providing a modest amount of funding for continued remediation of cyanobacteria in White Pond using the A-POD technology. This technology was successfully tested in 2021.
