## DUMPSTER PERMIT REFERENCE

**Effective January 1, 2016:** A permit issued by the Fire Department is required for any dumpster that is six cubic yards or greater.

Permit Fee: \$50.00

**Massachusetts Comprehensive Fire Code, 527CMR1.00:**

**1.12.8.5** Permit required for dumpsters > 6 cubic yards

**19.2.1.4** Rubbish Within Dumpsters. Dumpsters and containers with an individual capacity of 1.5 yd<sup>3</sup> [40.5 ft<sup>3</sup> (1.15 m<sup>3</sup>)] or more shall not be stored in buildings or placed within 10 ft (3 m) of combustible walls, openings, or combustible roof eave lines.
