As an adoptive parent of a catch basin, your obligation will be to monitor its health and well being by doing the following:

1. Periodically peer into your basin with a flashlight to ensure that it is not clogged with lawn clippings or leaves. Caution: Please do NOT try to lift the catch basin grates.
2. Call Concord Public Works / Highway at (978) 318-3220 to report dumping into the catch basin, or overflow of the catch basin.

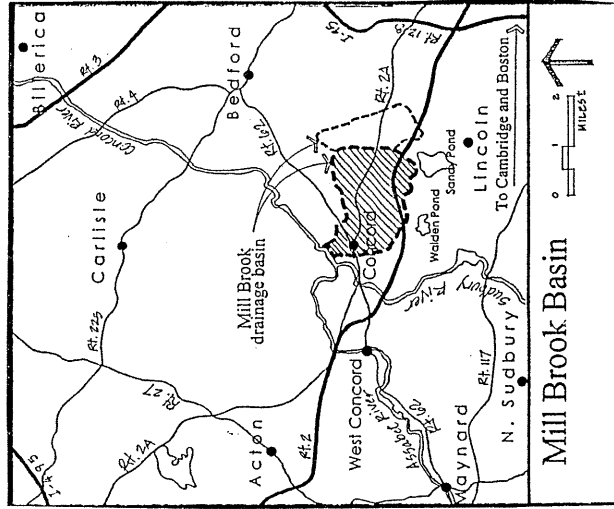
