CURBSIDE COLLECTION PROGRAM INFORMATION

10/1/22 – 3/31/23

Concord's Curbside Collection Program is fee funded. Tax dollars do not support the program. Subscribers pay two separate fees, a subscription fee and a disposal fee (barrel stickers or tags).

Follow these easy steps to sign up!

1. **Subscription:** Pay a Six Month Fee = Currently \$161.00 (Make your check payable to "Town of Concord" and deliver to the Treasurer's Office at 22 Monument Square.)
2. **Barrel Sticker or Tags** – Purchase your **\$46.80 barrel sticker** or **\$1.80 tags** at vendors shown on this page or online.
3. **Recycle Bins** – Come to 133 Keyes Rd during business hours to pick up your two free recycle bins!
4. **Place your Trash & Recycling at the curb on your pickup day by 7 A.M.**
5. **Once you've signed up you will receive a Renewal Notice every six months. You can renew online – and in addition, remember to purchase your barrel sticker/tags.**

Trash Barrels/Bags

Subscribers supply their own trash barrel (no larger than 34 gals), or bags (volume no greater than 34 gallons). Weight **cannot exceed 40 lbs.** for each bag or barrel (includes weight of barrel).

- Copy Paper, Envelopes & Stationary
- Cardboard flattened 30" x 30" maximum*



COMMINGLED

"Rinse Clean"

- Plastic bottles, jars, jugs, tubs w/#1-#5 logos
- Metal: Food & Beverage cans and tins.
- Glass Bottles & Jars – any color

(Tops and Lids Can be Left on Containers)

***CARDBOARD:** Large pieces can be flattened and brought to Cardboard Recycling Bins at 133 Keyes Road

Holidays/Weather – Monday holidays never affect the pickup schedule for Tuesday-Friday routes. If a major holiday falls on Tuesday-Friday, pickup will occur the following day. If Friday is your scheduled day, your pickup will be on Saturday. **If cancellation during inclement weather, your pickup day will be Saturday.**
