2023 SPECIAL TOWN MEETING UPDATE & SPECIAL TOWN ELECTION INFORMATION

Concord’s 2023 Special Town Meeting was called to order in the gymnasium and auditorium of the Concord Carlisle High School at 7:00 pm on Thursday, January 19, 2023 to take up five articles. A total of 1,106 voters were in attendance. The results of town meeting actions are listed below. Special Town Meeting dissolved at 8:38 pm on Thursday evening having concluded its legislative business.

- ✓ Early voting in person will be available at the Town House on Friday, February 10th from 8:30am until 4:30pm and on Saturday, February 11th from 10:00am until 2:00pm.
- ✓ Absentee voting in person is available at the Town Clerk’s Office until 12:00 noon on Wednesday, February 15, 2022.
- ✓ Absentee & Vote by mail ballots must be returned to the Town Clerk’s Office by 8:00pm on February 16th to be counted.
