



FITCHBURG COMMUTER RAIL LINE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT UPDATE

Construction Advisory **Main St. (Rt. 62) Concord - Road Closure** **August 26th through September 2nd** **MBTA Bridge Replacement Project**

As the MBTA and its contractor on the Fitchburg Main Line Improvement project proceed with improvements to the commuter rail line from Boston to Fitchburg, abutters in Concord can expect a total closure of Main Street/Route 62 scheduled to be in effect from 7am August 26th through 7am September 2nd to roll in the new bridge structure.

Access to all local residences will be maintained during construction. The full road closure will employ detour signage, variable message boards, and Police details to support the detours in effect during this temporary road closure.

After the new bridge is placed, single lane closures will continue to be employed on Main Street, (Route 62) through the Fall to allow for the completion of new railroad bridge abutments, sidewalks, and landscaping.

We apologize for any inconvenience this work may cause. These are once in a lifetime improvements essential to the rehabilitation of the Fitchburg Line. Customers can look forward to significant service improvements when this improvement project is completed.
