As discussed attached is the cost proposal for an intensive survey at the Park. It includes:

8 test pits along the wall

9 test pits in new tree planting locations

2 test pits at 2 sign locations

3 test pits at sitting location

**6 test pits in commemorative elements area**

**2 test pits in reserve to investigate any "features" that are found**

We have to apply for a state archaeologist's permit to do this survey, process artifacts that we recover (assumed 250), and write a report. MHC requires 2 hard copies of every report.

Let me know how the Town would like to proceed and as I said we can reduce the testing to only those areas you want tested.
