Items Accepted at DropOff

- **Appliances \$\$**
- **Bikes**
 - All types and conditions
- **Books**
 - good condition-no more than 10 years old
- **Carpeting \$\$**
 - carpeting & foam padding
- **CDs, DVDs, Video Games**
 - in original cases
- **Electronics \$\$**
 - Televisions, monitors, printers, keyboards, fax machines, VCRs, stereo equipment.
 - **NO devices containing data such as computers, laptops, tablets or cell phones*
- **Fluorescent and LED Bulbs**
- **Holiday Lights**
 - LED and Incandescent
- **Household Goods for Household Goods, Inc**
 - Pots & pans, dish sets, flatware
- **Mattress & Box Springs \$\$**
- **Oversize Waste \$\$**
 - items too large to be set out in the trash
- **Paper Shredding \$\$**
 - fee per banker's box
- **Printer Cartridges**
 - Inkjet or toner
- **Rags, Textiles and Towels**
 - clean towels, linens, fabric, curtains, clothing & rags
- **Rechargeable & Specialty Batteries**
 - Nickel-Cadmium, Lithium/Ion, Button Batteries
- **Rigid Plastics \$\$**
 - Playhouses, coolers, storage totes, trash barrels
- **Scrap Metal \$\$**
 - Grills, mowers and snow blowers (fuel and oil removed), metal pipe, lawn chairs, and other items containing at least 75% metal
- **Sneakers & Shoes**
- **Styrofoam Block \$\$**
 - clean, white only, in pre-purchased bags
- **Toilets & Porcelain Sinks \$\$**
- **Upholstered Furniture \$\$**
 - Sofas, sofa beds, loveseats, armchairs that are unusable-for usable furniture, check with Household Goods before disposing!

\$\$ indicates these items require payment. Pay online by credit card prior to the event.

All items **MUST BE IN GOOD, USABLE CONDITION** with no missing parts in order to be able to repurpose/recycle items.

SwapOff Volunteers will not be accepting/recycling items that should go to DropOff.

- No chips, cracks, tears, missing pieces, etc
- No “stockpiling” of goods. Everything will be on display at 12:00PM when the browsing opens.
- Items operating with batteries or electricity **MUST** be in good working order.
- Dishes, glassware, and flatware need to be in pairs (**no single items**)
- All items **MUST** be brought to the Swap in **carry size boxes labeled with contents and likewise items must be boxed together** (i.e. dishes packed with dishes, glasses with glasses, toys with toys, etc). Do not mix contents.
- *Anything brought to the Swap not packed and labeled as directed, will be turned away.*

<u>Acceptable Items</u>	<u>Unacceptable Items</u> <u>(Can be taken to the DropOff for Recycling or Disposal)</u>
<p>Artwork (framed and unframed) in good USABLE condition. No empty plastic frames.</p> <p>Camping Equipment – can’t be more than 5 years old and <i>no sleeping bags</i></p> <p>Dishes (place settings for 2, serving pieces) – No chips or cracks</p> <p>Electronics – Working laser printers (UNDER 10 YRS OLD), space heaters, vacuum cleaners, stereo speakers and digital flat screen televisions</p> <p>Flatware & Kitchen Utensils (boxed & labeled) NO KNIVES</p> <p>Games & Puzzles – make sure all pieces are present. In original boxes only.</p> <p>Garden Tools & Work Tools – No plastic planting pots</p> <p>Glasses – No single glasses or single coffee mugs</p> <p>Small Household appliances – must be in good condition & working order</p> <p>Small Household items – If one person can’t easily carry it don’t bring it - <i>must be able to carry in/carry out</i></p> <p>Sports Equipment: Baseball bats and gloves in good condition. Kids’ scooters/razors. Fully inflated soccer/basketballs. Tennis/Pickleball newer racquets in good condition. No sports shoes/boots, skates, skis, golf clubs or bags, lacrosse or hockey sticks.</p> <p>Toys –No oversized toys (playhouses, outdoor plastic toys or wading pools). Put Action figures and other small toys in ziploc baggies or small boxes. No stuffed animals, loose markers/crayons, children’s books or coloring books.</p>	<p>Backpacks</p> <p>Baskets</p> <p>Bicycles</p> <p>Books-adult and children</p> <p>Car Seats more than 3 years old</p> <p>Carpets & Rugs</p> <p>Clothing, Shoes, Textiles: includes rags & towels</p> <p>Cords/Cables</p> <p>Curtains and Curtain Rods</p> <p>DVD’s; CD’s in original cases</p> <p>Golf Clubs</p> <p>Hockey & Lacrosse Sticks</p> <p>Holiday Lights & Holiday Decorations</p> <p>Knick-Knacks</p> <p>Large Appliances</p> <p>Large Exercise Equipment</p> <p>Large Furniture</p> <p>Mirrors</p> <p>Office Furniture or file folders</p> <p>Old Electronics (older than 10 years old)</p> <p>Pillows</p> <p>Records in sleeves</p> <p>Televisions</p> <p>Sleeping Bags</p>
