



ARTICLE 14: CONCORD PUBLIC SCHOOLS CAPITAL PROJECTS

Mr. Herchek moves that the Town raise and appropriate the sum of \$501,430, to fund the FY27 Capital Improvement and Debt Plan, as printed in the Warrant, such funds to be expended under the direction of the Town Manager.



ARTICLE 14: CONCORD PUBLIC SCHOOLS CAPITAL PROJECTS

This article provides for a capital appropriation for Concord Public Schools, which serves students in pre-school, kindergarten, and grades 1 to 8.

The funding will support the various capital projects necessary to maintain and improve the district's schools, buildings, grounds, and related equipment and infrastructure.



ARTICLE 14: CONCORD PUBLIC SCHOOLS CAPITAL PROJECTS

Tier I projects include:

- \$125,780 (Alcott School) - Replace Building Management System
- \$20,000 (Alcott School) - Catch basin repairs
- \$15,000 (Alcott School) - Auditorium projector replacement
- \$20,000 (Thoreau) - Glycol mixing tank
- \$15,000 (Thoreau) - Floor scrubber
- \$40,000 (Willard) - Auditorium sound system replacement



ARTICLE 14: CONCORD PUBLIC SCHOOLS CAPITAL PROJECTS

Tier I projects (cont'd)

- \$34,650 (Willard) - Refurbish / Replace sections of building façade; repoint masonry and replace flashings, remove and replace sealant joints
- \$55,000 (Maintenance) Three yard stainless steel sander
- \$32,000 (District wide) Replacement of two copiers
- \$144,000 (Elementary) Touchscreen video board classroom units
