2015 Town Meeting voted to accept MGL c.53F- ¾
creating PEG Access and Cable-Related Fund

Payments formerly made by Comcast to CCTV are now
made directly to Town of Concord

Anticipated Payments in FY2018: \$392,000

Current Fund Balance: \$925,750

Law Requires Town Meeting to Appropriate Funds
Annually. Funds may only be used for PEG services
